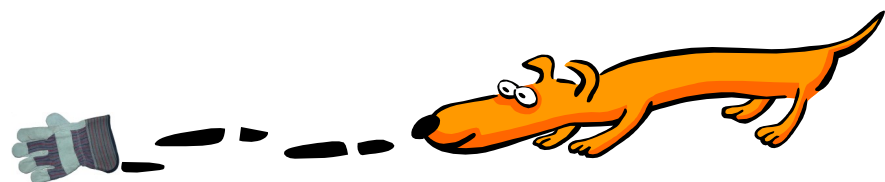

IMPORTANT NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

Test Limit and Random draw: this test is limited to 8 dogs. Entries will remain open until 7:00 pm, Wednesday, July 9, 2014. If entries received exceed the test limit of 8 TDU dogs, a public drawing will be held Wednesday, July 9, 2014, at 8:00 pm at the Starbucks coffee shop in King Soopers, E. Harmony road, Fort Collins, CO. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be emailed to all entrants as soon as possible.

Preference for the first two tracks drawn will be given to Buckhorn Valley Kennel Club test workers from the 2013 TD/TDX or VST tests (assuming their dogs do not already have a tracking title). When the advertised entry has been reached, any additional entries will be similarly drawn and placed on the alternate list. In all cases, preference will be given to dogs that have not yet earned a tracking title. When the advertised entry has been reached, any additional entries will be similarly drawn and placed on the alternate list. Entry Fee: TDU \$65. (The entry fee includes .50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC event service fee.) Make checks payable to BVKC and send to the event secretary:

Tracking Certificate: If the dog entered does not already have the TD or TDU title, please include a current tracking certificate with the entry.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" below), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Bitches in season may participate. The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

Use the official American Kennel Club entry form and write "TDU" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photo copies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

The order of running will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.
