## **IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS**

**TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW:** This test is limited to 7 dogs. Entries will remain open until Noon, THURSDAY, June 4, 2015. If entries received exceed the test limit of 7 VST dogs, a public drawing will be held THURSDAY, June 4, 2015, at 5:00 p.m. at the Loveland Public Library, 300 Adams Street, Loveland, CO. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be e-mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable.

Preference for the first two tracks drawn will be given to Buckhorn Valley Kennel Club test workers from the 2014 tests.

When the advertised entry has been reached, any additional entries will be similarly drawn and placed on the alternate list. In all cases, preference will be given to dogs that have not yet earned the VST title.

**ENTRY FEE:** VST-\$110.00. (The entry fee includes .50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC Event service fee.) Make checks payable to BVKC and send to the Event Secretary:

**ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" section of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made. Entries sent by overnight delivery must be marked "no signature required."

**BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE.** The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

**USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM** and write "VST" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

**THE ORDER OF RUNNING** will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

**ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER:** Dogs must have earned a TD or TDU to enter a Variable Surface Test.

**RISK:** The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Buckhorn Valley Kennel Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Any exhibitor whose dog passes a test AFTER the closing date for the Buckhorn Valley Kennel Club test but BEFORE the running of this test may withdraw their entry and receive full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing, by e-mail, with said message confirmed as received, or in person to the Test Secretary, and FURTHER PROVIDED that an alternate exhibitor is available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

### **AKC TRACKING TEST AND JUDGES GUIDELINES:**

**Chapter 5 Section 6. Visible Tracks:** "A Variable Surface Tracking site totally or partially covered in snow would not meet the criteria of three (3) different surfaces including vegetated and non-vegetated surfaces. Snow-covered portions of a site may seriously affect the proper utilization of the site as a whole."

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly by any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
